Led by Filipino leaders, influencers and celebrities, members of the community – all ages, all genders – wore blue, red, and white t-shirts and formed an image of the Philippine Flag while walking in the streets of Calgary Downtown.

With a very short time to prepare, the organizers of this participation have pulled off another successful event. From gathering the contingent to practicing the flag formation.

This year, they brought live music that made the spectators dance. YYC-PH Drumbeaters created such beautiful noise that echoed through the concrete jungle of Calgary Downtown. 

For Jayjay, Sophia, and Keanna, establishing MRFSA has been challenging but rewarding. Despite the difficulties, they all recognize that their journey has built resilience and nurtured personal growth. Additionally, leading the club taught them to work together despite having different visions, making them learn more about themselves.

These three promising youth leaders aspire for MRFSA to endure long. They hope the club remains a space and community for learning, joy, and friendships. Above all, they wish for the club to stay embedded in the spirit of Bayanihan.





# PHILLY STEAK BENEDICT By Allan Dela Cruz





# **Ingredients:**

½ WAFFLE
5 OZ. PHILLY STEAK
1 PC. POTATO RUSSET (FOR HASHBROWN)
ASSORTED FRUITS
SALT AND PEPPER
2 POACHED EGGS
2 OZ HOLLANDAISE SAUCE

# Waffle Ingredients:

3 LARGE EGGS 60 ML CORN OIL 275 PANCAKE FLOUR 250 ML EVAPORATED MILK

# **Philly Steak Ingredients:**

5 OZ. SLICED BEEF
1 TBSP. ALFREDO SAUCE
10 GR. PARMESAN CHEESE
15 GR. WHITE ONION
20 GR. RED PEPPER
20 GR. SLICED MUSHROOMS
5 TSP OREGANO
SALT AND PEPPER

# **Procedure:**

# A. Philly Steak

- 1. Sauté thinly sliced onion, red pepper and mushrooms in canola oil over medium-low heat. You want to avoid browning the peppers and onions so if they do begin to brown, reduce the heat under the pan a bit. When they are nice and tender, transfer them to a large dish and set aside.
- 2. Add additional oil to the pan and then add the sliced beef to the hot pan.

  Season with Parmesan cheese, salt and pepper, oregano and Alfredo sauce.

  Cook and stir until browned and add the cooked vegetables and set aside

### **B.** Hashbrown \*\*for best quality prepare a day before

- 1. Peeled potato and cut them into cubes, half inch in size
- 2. Boiled them until soft. Drain them and put them in the freezer overnight.
- 3. Deep fried them from frozen. Season with salt, oregano and parsley.

### C. Waffle

- 1. Separate egg yolk and egg white. Mix together the egg yolks, corn oil, evaporated milk and pancake flour in a large bowl. Using a wooden spoon, mix them until it is smooth with no large lumps.
- 2. Using a mixer, beat egg whites in full speed until stiff peaks.
- 3. Pour four ounces of batter in waffle iron and cook them for 4 minutes.

### **Assemble**

- 1. Put half waffle in the plate and placed Philly steak on the top of the waffle. Top with two poached eggs and 2 ounces of hollandaise sauce. Garnish it with parsley and dust it with paprika.
- 2. Add a bowl of fruits and hashbrown. Served hot.
